What is Heart2Heart?

Heart2Heart is a collaboration of specialist heart nurses and doctors, and the team from Hospiscare, offering support and advice to patients and their carers over a five session programme. The session participants are patients and carers who come together to learn from each other through chatting in a social setting.

Why would joining Heart2Heart help me?

We understand that when you are diagnosed with heart failure it can be a very difficult diagnosis to hear and you may be left with lots of questions around your illness, its treatment, the future and how to support those that are important to you. Often people want hints and tips from others that are going through the same thing.

What happens at the sessions?

At each session there will be set topics to discuss and there are always both heart failure nurses and Hospiscare nurses involved to support conversations. There is also a complementary therapist available to offer relaxation therapies, if you so wish.

Where and when are the sessions held?

These sessions will be held face to face, details of the location will be added into your invite letter. This is something we will continue to review for your safety.
