What is Tour de Devon?

Tour de Devon is a cycling challenge in aid of Hospiscare, the local adult hospice charity for Exeter, Mid and East Devon. Choose your challenge distance of 50, 100, 250 or 400 miles and plan your own route at your own pace, around your favourite parts of Devon with friends, family or colleagues. Whether you're a seasoned pro, a casual rider or looking to get out on your bike more, sign up to Tour de Devon and help fund expert end-of-life and palliative care in our community. Tour de Devon is the challenge for you!

Pick your distance and challenge yourself to complete it between 1st September and Thursday 30th September.

Want more of challenge? Set yourself a longer distance and just let us know. Tour de Devon is – your route – your pace – your way.

Is there a registration fee?

Yes, £10 for adults or £5 children. This fee covers the cost of your medal and the administration of the event– your fundraising will help enable Hospiscare to support patients and their families across Exeter, Mid and East Devon.

Where is Tour de Devon?

The route is your choice! Cycle anywhere from your home or locally to you. All we ask is that you stick to the government guidance on social distancing and all Covid-19 measures.

What are the dates of the challenge?

Wednesday 1st September to Thursday 30th September. You can complete your challenge in any time frame within these days.

Can I start Tour de Devon today?

Of course! If the event dates don't work for you, change the dates to a time that suits. However, it is important that you let us know when you're planning to complete your challenge so we can arrange to send you your medal.

Is there an age limit for Tour de Devon?

This event is open to participants of all ages, however children under 16 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult. Hospiscare do not take responsibility for the safety of cyclists and you undertake the ride at your own risk.

Is there a minimum fundraising amount?

We are hoping each rider will raise a minimum of £60 to help support Hospiscare.

If 200 riders all raised £60 that would be an amazing £12,000 for Hospiscare! This could pay for 333 hours of bereavement support.

When will I receive my medal?

Once the challenge is completed we'll be sending out your medals in early October.

Can I complete Tour de Devon on a static bike?

Yes, you can join in on any type of bike including a static bike. All we ask is that you ensure your static bike is in good working order. Hospiscare do not take responsibility for the safety of cyclists or their bikes or static bikes.
